

# **ARIZONA QUICK 32 SERIES**

## **2008 General Rules**

### **SECTION 1 - PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS**

1. Driver must have a MINIMUM of **one** full year of competition experience in a junior dragster. All drivers will be a minimum of 10 years of age and possess a valid NHRA or IHRA Junior Dragster participant license. The one year of participation must be verified by an Arizona Quick 32 Series director.
2. All drivers' performance and driving abilities will be reviewed during every event. If at any time, during competition, it is determined by any valid Race Official that any participant is jeopardizing anyone's safety, or is not properly qualified to compete, that participant shall be excluded from any further competition at that event and shall face a mandatory review by the Arizona Quick 32 Series directors before being allowed to compete again.
3. All junior dragster vehicles will meet all of the current NHRA safety and construction rules and shall be required to pass the hosting tracks technical inspection as well as NHRA weight limits.
4. All junior dragster drivers and team managers will be required to attend the drivers meetings.
5. All drivers **MUST** have a signed release form on file with the Arizona Quick 32 Series and the hosting track.

### **SECTION 2- RACE PROCEDURES**

1. The race format shall be run on a 330' timed track
2. There will be two qualifying runs prior to the start of eliminations to determine qualifying position.
3. A 5/10s FULL Pro tree will be utilized for all elimination and qualifying attempts
4. Pairing will be determined utilizing a SPORTSMAN LADDER. (i.e. #1 vs. #17, #2 vs. #18, #3 vs. #19, #4 vs. #20, and so on.)
5. Participant must dial within 1/10th of a second of their best qualifying time and at no time is allowed to dial quicker than 4.10 seconds.
6. Points toward year end championship will be awarded to driver only. Points will only be awarded to competitor & car owner in good standing with the Southwest 330 Series.
7. A 32 car field will be qualified at all Events unless there are fewer than 28 cars entered, in which case a 16 car field will be laddered for that event. In the case of 28 or more cars, but less than 32, a 32 car ladder will be used with the higher qualified cars receiving the buy run in the first round of eliminations.
8. Any protest or question must be voiced **PRIOR** to Participant staging his/her car. If you take the tree, the run will stand.
9. Courtesy Staging will be in effect at all times. Both contestants must activate their pre-stage lights **before** either entry may advance. Auto start may be used at the discretion of the track.

10. CREW MEMBER is not allowed to touch the car in any manner after the PRE-STAGE bulb is lit in your lane! Driver will be disqualified and shutdown immediately if this infraction occurs.
11. Any protest or question must be voiced PRIOR to Participant staging his/her car. If you take the tree, the run will stand.
12. The participant with the quicker qualifying e.t. will have lane choice during 1st round of eliminations. Subsequent round lane choice goes to the driver with the quickest e.t. from the previous round.
13. Points toward year end championship will be awarded to driver only. Points will only be awarded to competitor & car owner in good standing with the Arizona Quick 32 Series.
14. All cars are subject to being weighed at any time at the discretion of the Arizona Quick 32 Series Race Director.
15. The final eight (8) cars will be impounded at the end of the respective runs and be subject to being weighted. No crew member shall touch or approach the car until the car has been weighed or released by an Arizona Quick 32 Series Race Director. Failure to follow this rule will result in an immediate disqualification and forfeiture of all points earned for that event.

**THIS SET OF RULES IS INTENDED AS A GUIDE TO REFLECT THE ARIZONA QUICK 32 SERIES RULES IN GENERAL.** If something is not specifically ALLOWED in these rules you are advised to check with the Arizona Quick 32 Series Race Director BEFORE you attempt to race at an Arizona Quick 32 Series event. Regarding all rules pertaining to safety, the host tracks rules will take precedent over the Arizona Quick 32 Series rules under all circumstances.

### SECTION 3 – ARIZONA QUICK 32 SERIES POINTS SYSTEM

Points are earned as follows;	Attempt to qualify=	10 points
	Each round entered=	20 points
	Event Win=	20 points

#### Qualifying Position Points:

#1 = 16 points	#6 = 11 points	#11 = 6 points	#16-32 =1 point
#2 = 15 points	#7 = 10 points	#12 = 5 points	
#3 = 14 points	#8 = 9 points	#13 = 4 points	
#4 = 13 points	#9 = 8 points	#14 = 3 points

#### General Information:

1. There shall be a \$25 per year, per driver membership/participation fee.
2. The entry fee per driver shall be \$25 per event plus applicable track tech card fee.
3. Failure to qualify will warrant a full entry fee refund, but NOT the host track tech card fee.
4. Failure to qualify will mean NOT making the 32 car entry limit cut off. Mechanical failure or other reasons for not qualifying after submission of an official tech card will not be subject to an entry fee refund for that event.
5. There will be \$15 of the entry fee per qualified car added back to the events overall purse with \$10 being retained for future award considerations.
